WHO WE ARE

Our mission is to model the compassion of Jesus as we strive for a hunger-free tristate.

We reflect God's love through collaboration, compassion, and faith. Partnering with hundreds of nonprofits, Master Provisions (MP) provides access to nourishing food and resources so all can thrive. We are better together and our collective impact changes lives.

WHO SERVES WITH US

MP hosts hundreds of volunteers every year. They serve in the warehouse and around the office in various roles. In 2025 alone, volunteers worked for **19,656 hours**, which is equivalent to \$625,063 worth of donated time or **9.5 full-time positions**.

WHO WE SERVE

In 2025, Master Provisions supplied 228 agency partners who directly served communities in the OH/KY/IN/WV region. MP serves these agencies by rescuing and redistributing food and other resources that would otherwise be thrown away. This year alone, 2,446,641 pounds of food were rescued and redistributed to our agency partners. MP is working to end food insecurity and food waste through this collaborative approach. Because of these partnerships, approximately 82,000 people receive food from MP each month.

MP MASTER PROVISIONS HIS HEROES

His Heroes is a Master Provisions program designed to empower individuals with disabilities by helping them build life skills, social skills, and workplace readiness through hands-on volunteer work. We work with 18 schools and organizations, such as The Point Arc.

A NEW SPACE. A GREATER IMPACT.

- The Toebben Drive warehouse is 30,000 square feet, nearly double the size of our previous 17,000 square foot building on Foundation Drive.
- Due to the new racking system and vertical capabilities, we can store nearly 10 times the pallets of product we stored at our old facility.
- MP's new Cooler/Freezer is double the size of our old one and taller than our entire Foundation Drive building was, providing 3,000 square feet of cold food storage.
